people even if they don't care much about cars. He said businesses on Macomb's square, especially restaurants, do well on nights when the event is held.


Since the cruise does not place cars into classes and no trophies are awarded, the evenings are an opportunity for car connoisseurs to share their cars in a laid-back atmosphere.
